### Boy Scout Adult Leader Training

**What:** **Scoutmaster / Asst SM Leader Specific Training (SM / ASM LST)**  
**Why:** Position-specific training for new Scoutmasters, Assistant SM's, and all interested Scout leaders.  
**When:** **Saturday, Sept 18, 2010**, from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm. (at Merit Badge Workshop)  
**Where:** Bannockburn Baptist Church, in SW Austin (1 block from Wm. Cannon & Brodie Lane)  
**Cost:** \$12.00 (includes the cost of training materials).  
**What to bring:** Your Class A Uniform and a pen. You may want a Scoutmaster Handbook or Boy Scout Handbook. A participant notebook will be provided.  
**Topics include:** Troop Organization, The Eight Methods, Safety, The Role of the Scoutmaster, Advancement, Troop Program Planning, Working with Youth Leaders, and lots more!  
**Prerequisites:** You should have completed both 'This is Scouting' (online) and 'Fast Start' (online).

**What:** **Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)**  
**Why:** Second half companion course to SM/ASM LST course; this is an overnight camping/training event.  
**When:** **Weekend of Oct 22-24, 2010** (from Friday about 6:30 pm until Sunday about noon).  
You need to plan to attend this entire event.  
**Where:** Lost Pines Scout Reservation (LPSR) in Bastrop. (part of Council's Mega-Training Weekend)  
**Cost:** \$35.00 (includes the cost of food plus training materials).  
**What to bring:** Your Class A Uniform, pen, Boy Scout Handbook (suggested), folding chair, tent, sleeping bag, raincoat, mess kit, eating utensils, coffee mug, flashlight, compass, personal items, etc. (Everything you'd need for a typical weekend Troop campout, including your current BSA Medical Form. You'll get a checklist at the end of SM/ASM LST Training.)  
**Topics include:** Knots, Fire Building, First Aid, Cooking, Map & Compass, and other outdoor skills needed to get a new Scout up to First Class rank. **Yes, this IS the "Knives & Fire" course!**  
**Prerequisites:** Should have completed 'This is Scouting', Fast Start, and SM/ASM LST (see above).  
 We recommend that you take IOLS right after you complete SM/ASM LST training.

**Who should attend these courses:** Adult Leaders who are or will be planning and/or assisting with a Boy Scout Troop's programs. SM and ASM leaders are considered "Trained" after completing:
