Boy Scout Adult Leader Training

What: Scoutmaster / Asst SM Leader Specific Training (SM / ASM LST)
Why: Position-specific training for new Scoutmasters, Assistant SM's, and other interested Scout leaders.
When: **Saturday, Mar 7, 2009**, 8:30 am – 5:00 pm.
Where: Buda United Methodist Church, 302 Elm St, Buda, TX 78610 (just NW of FM 967 and Main St).
Cost: \$10.00 (includes the cost of training materials; lunch will be provided).
What to bring: Your Class A Uniform and a pen. You may want a Scoutmaster Handbook or Boy Scout Handbook. A participant notebook will be provided.
Topics include: Troop Organization, The Eight Methods, Safety, The Role of the Scoutmaster, Advancement, Troop Program Planning, Working with Youth Leaders, and lots more!
Prerequisites: You should have completed both New Leader Essentials (NLE) and Fast Start (online).

What: Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)
Why: Second half companion course to SM/ASM LST course; this is an overnight camping/training event.
When: **One weekend, Mar 27-29, 2009** (from Friday about 6:30 pm until Sunday about noon). You need to plan to attend this entire event.
Where: Lost Pines Scout Reservation (LPSR) in Bastrop.
Cost: \$30.00 (includes the cost of food plus training materials).
What to bring: Your Class A Uniform, pen, Boy Scout Handbook (suggested), folding chair, tent, sleeping bag, raincoat, mess kit, eating utensils, coffee mug, flashlight, compass, personal items, etc. (Everything you'd need for a typical weekend Troop campout, including your current BSA Medical Form. You'll get a checklist at the end of SM/ASM LST Training.)
Topics include: Knots, Fire Building, First Aid, Cooking, Map & Compass, and other outdoor skills needed to get a new Scout up to First Class rank. **Yes, this IS the "Knives & Fire" course!**
Prerequisites: Should have completed New Leader Essentials, Fast Start, and SM/ASM LST (see above).

Who should attend these courses: Adult Leaders who are currently or soon will be planning and/or assisting with a Boy Scout Troop's programs. A Leader is considered "Trained" after completing:

- **Fast Start, and Youth Protection** both can be taken online at <http://olc.scouting.org/>
- **New Leader Essentials (NLE),**
- **SM/ASM Leader Specific Training (SM/ASM LST),** and
- **Intro to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS).**
