### Pandemic Protocol Camper Equipment

### = Optional \*\*\* = shared with Buddy

#### 1. Clothes-

- 2 face masks
- hiking boots/shoes
- nylon pants (wicking could be zip off)
- nylon shorts(wicking)
- wicking sports bra
- wicking shirt
- sun cap
- Camp shoes ###
- Sleep clothes
- gloves ###
- fleece or wool jacket for warm layer ###
- 2 pair hiking sock liners ###
- 3 pair hiking socks
- 2 dry wicking underwear
- Bandana

**Dressed in these clothes with appropriate  
outerwear ready for the weather conditions  
during campout.**

#### 2. Backpacking backpack with rain cover ###

#### 3. Small 1 or 2 person tent

#### 4. Stove- in Ziploc bag ###

(depends upon food/meal plan)

- stick matches or torch lighter
- aluminum windscreen
- **Choose 1 -**
  - A. Esbit stove & fuel tabs
  - B. Small propane stove (pocket rocket)

#### 5. Kitchen – all in a Ziploc bag or Mesh dip bag

(@depends upon food/meal plan)

- lightweight aluminum pot with lid & handle (2 cups capacity) @
- Lightweight plastic cutting board @
- plastic cup with measurement marks @
- small bottle of liquid detergent soap
- bandana
- small scouring pad (cut kitchen pad in half or fourths)

#### 6. Utensils - in Mesh dip bag

- lightweight eating bowl
- fork & spoon or spork
- drinking cup

#### 7. Water-

- Plastic bottles or water bladder filled with water (**2 Liters Minimum**)
- Water filtration and purification system ###
- Collapsible water bag ###

#### 8. Misc. -

- 40-50 feet of parachute cord
- Whistle
- Headlamp or small flashlight
- Compass ###
- Rain jacket or rain poncho
- 3 large heavy-duty trash bags
- Pocket knife (if Toten chip is earned)

#### 9. Sleeping -

- Lightweight sleeping pad
- sleep hat (beanie) ###
- lightweight at least 30 degree sleeping bag in stuff-sack
- pillow ###
- trash bag for additional water protection of sleeping bag

#### 10. Bathroom -in Ziploc bag

- SheWee (female urination device) ###
- 1 Roll of Toilet Paper (none in port-o-potty)
- 8oz hand sanitizer bottle
- 1 panty liner per day

#### 11. First Aid Kit- in Ziploc bag

- Emergency ID card
- sunblock
- bug spray
- tube of antiseptic ointment
- band-aids
- other first aid items you choose
- prescribed medication
- (F.A.K. & Meds to be reported to First Aider)

#### 12. Toiletries – in a Ziploc bag

- travel size toothbrush & paste
- 2 bandana or washcloth/towel
- small soap
- small deodorant ###
- small comb or brush
- menstrual supplies
