

# Camping Safety protocols

\*\*\*\*\*  
Screening at arrival in front of driver(questions and forehead thermometer)

Large container disinfecting wipes

Handwashing station (table large bottle of hand sanitizer)

Handwashing station (disinfecting soap at water sources)

Take attendance at each activity for possible contact tracing

All activities will be performed outdoors

No sharing of anything

Face masks required (except while eating)

Hourly hand sanitizing/washing of hands

Scouts must pitch their own tents

Tents must socially distanced 10 ft apart

No tent sharing – everyone sleeps separately

Cook(s) wears a mask and gloves at all times and cook(s) clean cookware

Gloves and mask required when handling communal food

Gloves and mask required when handling Axes

Individual dish washing kits (soap, sponge) – Everyone cleans their own dishes

Each Scout brings their own bottle of hand sanitizer

Toileting (port-o-potty) – there is hand sanitizer in the bathroom – table with hand sanitizer station outside the potty. There is no toilet paper in the potty. Protocol – USE SANITIZER prior to entering the potty, after you enter (because you touched the door) before you “go”, after you “go” and after you exit the port-o-potty (because you touched the door) – potty will not have toilet paper (Everyone will bring their own toilet paper). Spray disinfectant will be located inside the potty so that you can spray the stall and toilet before you exit.
