

T19 Camping Safety protocols

Safety protocol zoom meeting (prerequisite)

Self screening prior to event (document will be provided)

Screening at arrival in front of parent (questions and forehead thermometer)

Large container disinfecting wipes

Handwashing station (table with a gallon of hand sanitizer)

Take attendance at each activity for possible contact tracing

All activities will be performed outdoors

No sharing of anything

Face masks required (except while eating)

Hourly hand sanitizing/washing of hands

Scouts must pitch their own tents

Tents must socially distanced 10 ft apart

No tent sharing – everyone sleeps separately (must practice putting up tent, so that they will not need assistance)

Cook wears a mask and gloves at all times and cook cleans cookware

Gloves and mask required when handling communal food

Individual dish washing kits (soap, scrubbing sponge) – Scouts clean their own dishes

Each Scout brings their own bottle of hand sanitizer

Toileting (port-o-potty) – hand sanitizer in the bathroom – table with hand sanitizer station outside the potty. Protocol – use sanitizer prior to entering the potty, after they enter (because they touched the door) before they “go”, after they “go” and after they exit the port-o-potty (because they touched the door) – it will not have toilet paper (Scouts will bring their own – in packing list). Spray disinfectant will be located inside the port-o-potty so that Scouts can spray the stall before they exit.

Signs will be posted around camp with the Safety protocols. A sign on bathroom safety will be posted inside an outside the bathroom.
